

DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S CITATION
2017-2018

The District Governor's Citation for Rotary Year 2017-2018 recognizes and honors outstanding clubs for an array of achievements that promote membership growth, enhance humanitarian service through The Rotary Foundation and support our youth.

This year's District Governor's Citation is a point based system. Each activity is valued at either 5 or 10 points depending on the difficulty level. The total points available are 250. A club must attain 175 points to win the Governor's Citation.

A club does not have to accrue a minimum amount of points in every area. This way, a club that is stronger in one area can gather more points in that area.

The final date for achieving the requirements and submitting the application is June 30, 2018.
