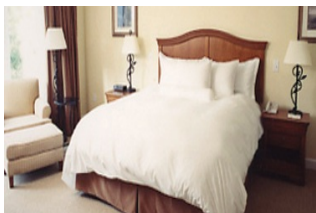

The River and Woods Courses were both ranked in *Golf Week Magazine's* Top 100 of America's Best Golf Courses. There will be a Golf Tournament (18 holes) and a Club Par 3 Golf Competition during the weekend. So, all you golfers get ready for Tee Time!



Kingsmill's Tennis Club features 15 tennis courts (13 clay and two hard surfaces) and an excellent Pro Shop.

Kingsmill's Sports Club includes a fitness center with state-of-art equipment and free weights, dedicated aerobic floor, 2 racquetball courts, game room, indoor/outdoor pools and locker facility with steam room, sauna and whirlpool. They provide bicycle rentals and a four-mile jogging/walking path.

The European Spa Facility is located in the Sports Club and offers a wide range of products such as body treatments, massages, hair care, manicures/pedicures and many other services.

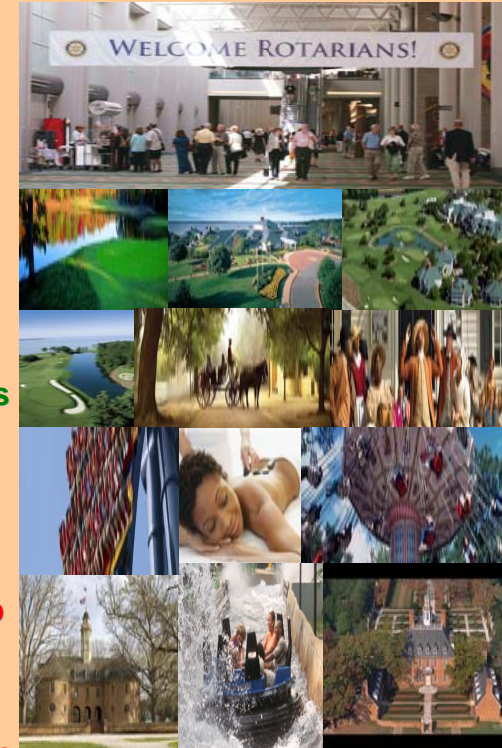
