

7610 AWARDS

- Clubs submit ONE form, outlining all projects and other achievements for the year.
- There is no breakdown as to Avenues of Service. Clubs are rated for their overall service.
- There is no delineation for size of club.
- Clubs will not compete against each other. Clubs are recognized on their own merit.



There will be nine awards:

- Three Award Levels:
 - Exceptional
 - Exemplary
 - Meritorious
- Three awards in each level

- The Awards Committee may opt not to give an award at any level if it is felt there are insufficient accomplishments to merit an award.
- Presidential Citations are a separate program.

MULTI-CLUB PROJECT AWARD

- A special, Multi-Club Project Award may be given.
- All clubs participating in a multi-club project must be located within Zone 33 to be eligible.

DISTRICT 7610 CLUB AWARDS

Each year, the District recognizes the outstanding work (service projects, fundraisers, club activities, Public Image efforts) accomplished by clubs in District 7610.

Each club, regardless of number of members, has projects for which they are known and appreciated-both in their own community, and in the greater world of Rotary.

Recognition of accomplishments is not a competition, measuring clubs against each other. It is an acknowledgment that the Service Above Self of a club is: *Exceptional, Exemplary or Meritorious.*

The entire body of work of a club represents its effectiveness and each club is unique.
