- Conduct joint Rotary & Scout community service projects that emphasize Rotary, Interact, Rotaract, Early Generations and Scout participation;
- Recognize Scouts who have received either the Eagle Scout or Gold Awards;
- Recognize Rotarians and Rotaractors who have rendered distinguished service to Rotary & Scouting with the Cliff Dochterman Award;
- Recruit Scouting professionals and volunteers as Rotarians;
- Encourage Rotarians to become active in Scouting;
- Sponsor a Scout unit(s) or a Scouting activity in your community;
- Encourage Rotarians to join the IFSR.
