Youth Speech Contest Judging Procedure

Identical score sheets will be used at all levels of the competition. Each judge weighs each speech in the range of 1 - 100 points within three sets of criteria:

The highest scored speech will be declared the winner.

Penalties will be imposed if the contestant arrives late or the speech is not within the required time frame.

In the case of a tie:

- 1. The contestant with the highest scores for Delivery and Presentation will be declared the winner.
- 2. If a tie still remains, the contestant with the highest score for Originality will be declared the winner.
- 3. The decision of the judges is final.

NOTE: Judges must NOT confer during or after a speech. After all score sheets have been given the tellers, then the judges may confer. Individual scores will not be announced.
